





- In 1974, he gave up private practice to enter dental education; in his words, "to make a contribution - a difference," and he became passionate about the importance and role of the general practitioner in healthcare.
- Director of the General Practice Residency program at Charity Hospital, LA and the head of the Dept. of General Dentistry, Louisiana State University, 1978.
- Director of the Hospital General Practice Residency program and Director of the Hospital Dental Clinic at the University of Iowa until he retired, 1983 – 1992.



- After officially retiring from IUSD in 1992, continued to teach two days per week until 2014 (at age 91).
- Served in the US Army during World War II.
- Founding member, ABOD.
