

Jeffery S. Nordin, DDS, MS

Biography:

Dr. Nordin was raised in Jamestown, NY and attended SUNY at Buffalo where he received a BS in Biology. He continued to SUNY at Buffalo School of Dental Medicine, receiving his DDS degree in 1989. He went on to complete a Master's in Operative Dentistry and a certificate in Preventive Dentistry from the University of Iowa in 2000. He also received his Board certification from the American Board of Operative Dentistry in 2003.

CAPT Nordin retired after 32 years of service in the United States Navy. He formerly served as the Navy Surgeon General's Specialty Leader for Operative Dentistry. He was also the chair, Department of Operative Dentistry at the Naval Postgraduate Dental School in Bethesda, MD.

Upon retirement, he accepted a position at the UTHSC College of Dentistry in Memphis TN where he served as the Director of Operative Dentistry and as a Group Leader. Dr. Nordin currently works as a Government Service Dentist for the United States Navy at Naval Air Station, Pensacola, FL.
